MODIFICATION APPLICATION

The Panel determined to **defer consideration** of the modification application until 19th December 2024 to allow additional information to be provided regarding the original roof treatment and proposed. The reason for the changing to the decking material, the options considered and a comparison of the sustainability of materials determined and the current proposal.
