Beat the Heat

An El Nino event is looking likely, which means that we can expect a very hot spring and summer. It is important that you plan and prepare for extreme heat events.

- Avoid the sun and try to be indoors during the hottest part of the day. Shade your windows to keep heat out.
- Wear loose fitting clothing.
- Drink plenty of water speak to your doctor about how much water you should be drinking
 in hot weather, especially if they normally limit your fluids. Avoid hot, alcoholic or sugary
 drinks as they can make dehydration worse.
- Use air conditioning at home or visit public places with air conditioning (the Dougherty Centre and Chatswood Library are both available for this).
- Speak to your doctor and follow their advice about medication and any pre-existing medical conditions in a heatwave.
- Have a plan of who to call if you need help.
- Prepare an emergency kit in case of power failure (radio, torch, water etc).
- Keep cool packs or spray bottles of water in your fridge to help you cool down.

At Home with Willoughby offer a home-delivery shopping service which you can use to avoid going out to the shops in hot weather. We also offer an 'Out & About' car service which can collect you from home and take you to locations within the Willoughby area. This means you won't need to walk and wait at a bus stop in the heat. All main meals are made locally using fresh ingredients without preservatives, and provide excellent value for money. Main meals are \$8.20 for Commonwealth Home Support Program clients.

All meals meet the Meals on Wheels National Meal Guidelines, so you know you will be receiving healthy meals that meet your nutritional needs. Meals are balanced to ensure adequate protein, fibre and energy to empower you to continue to live independently and maintain (or improve!) your quality of life.

Meals on Wheels National Meal Guidelines

All meals delivered as part of the Meals on Wheels program must meet the Meals on Wheels National Meal Guidelines.

This means that you can be sure that the meals delivered to you contain adequate protein, fibre and carbohydrates to help prevent malnutrition. The meals are vaired to ensure that you receive a range of food groups across the week.

SHOPPING **SERVICES**



All Aboard! The Tuesday Shopping Bus



The SHOPPING BUS will pick you up from your home and drop you off at the Spring Street entrance of Westfield Shopping Centre at 12 noon. You will have approximately 2 hours for shopping before the bus returns at 2pm to take you home. Cost \$8.30 for the return trip or \$5.70 one-way.

Companion Shopping

Individually assisted Companion Shopping services can be arranged for residents living in the Willoughby area who have low vision or a mobility issue that prevents them from using public transport or the shopping bus. This service can be utilised fortnightly, monthly or on an ad-hoc basis. Cost is \$21 for a 2 hour service.

Home Delivered Groceries

At Home with Willoughby can organise a home delivery of groceries through Coles or Woolworths Online Shopping. You will need to have a debit or credit card.

Our friendly volunteers will contact you by phone on Mondays and take your order. It will be processed through the internet and Coles or Woolworths will deliver your groceries to your door later in the week, generally on a Thursday. There is no cost from At Home with Willoughby for this service but Coles and Woolworths do charge a delivery fee dependant on the timeframe you choose for delivery. You can choose whether you prefer to receive groceries from Coles or Woolworths.

LINEN SERVICE



At Home with Willoughby Linen Service

The Linen Service provides freshly laundered sheets, pillowcases and towels to eligible clients living in the Willoughby local government area.

A team of caring volunteers visits your home each fortnight on a Tuesday morning to deliver the fresh linen and towels and to remake your bed. Used linen is collected and sent out to a commercial laundry for cleaning.

The cost of the service is \$14 per bed. Clients receive an invoice at the end of each month and direct debit can be set up for ease of payment.
