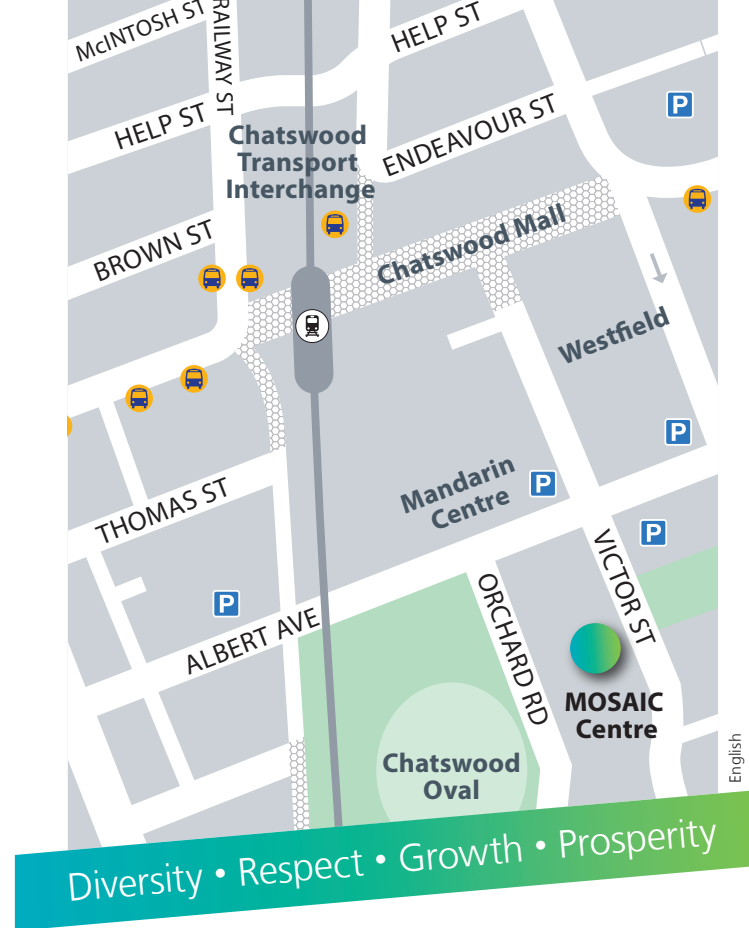


Alice Cheng
