



WPC does not provide written confirmation. Enrolments are accepted on a first in, first served basis. Receipts are available from the administration office upon request. Payment - Payment by credit card, eftpos, or cheque. Additional fees and charges may apply. Please refer to Willoughby City Council Feesand Charges 2024/2025 GST included as applicable. Concessions - 10% for Pensioners and Health Care cardholders. 5% for Seniors and Tertiary students. To receive concession please show card and enter number on enrolment form. Refunds - Please choose your course carefully. We do not give refunds for change of mind or personal circumstances. A refund may be considered if you provide a written request at least five working days before class commencement. Cancellations - Should WPC management need to cancel a class for any reason, you will be advised of a replacement class date. If WPC management does not provide a replacement class you will be issued with a refund. Indemnity - Students/Parent/Carer of Students of Centres
